

# Student Dress Code/ School Uniform

Lawnton State School students are expected to wear a school uniform that is endorsed by the P&C, in conjunction with guidelines of Education Queensland. Parents should understand that basic to these guidelines is the belief that there is a standard of dress which is appropriate for school. We believe, and we are sure you support the view, that it is good preparation for life and future employment. Children need to recognise and understand that community has standards of conduct and dress, which are appropriate for various situations and occasions. For these reasons we know that we can anticipate your co-operation.

1. On all occasions children should be clean and neatly attired and dressed in school uniform.
2. Hair is to be clean and neatly groomed. It is recommended that shoulder length hair be kept tied up to tied back. No hair colour is to be worn.
3. Footwear is black closed in shoes or sneakers/joggers with black shoelaces giving appropriate protection. Socks (white/black/navy) are to be worn to prevent odour problems.
4. Hat is to be a wide brimmed school hat (with Logo) to provide appropriate sun protection.
5. Jewellery may include simple ear studs or sleepers, a watch, medical ID bracelet and religious jewellery. Facial piercing is not permitted including eye-brow, nose or lip piercing.

## **General Uniform:**

***Unisex wear:*** navy polo shirt with a yellow and white strip, navy blue rugby knit shorts

***Girls' wear:*** navy blue skorts (leggings are not permitted)

## **House Sports Uniform:**

To be worn only on Sports Days or other sporting activities in place of their general uniform. Teachers will advise when this is appropriate. Plain coloured shirts worn with navy blue shorts.

***House colours*** – Rungi – red. Bindar – blue. Yarri – yellow. Guyra - green.

**Shoes:** Sneakers/Joggers

## ***Winter Additions:***

Navy blue jumper or jacket with plain navy blue tracksuit pants (hoodies and leggings are not permitted)

These restrictions are in place as they are in adherence with the Workplace Health and Safety Act. Dress items not approved at any time

The following items are not considered appropriate and are not to be worn at school.

ITEM	REASON
Offensive slogans on shirts and hats	Offensive to others
Thongs/sandals/open footwear	Awkward/lack of protection
Bike pants/tights (unless under a skirt for sports Activities)	Hygiene, not part of the approved school Uniform
Homeboy or board shorts	Not part of the approved school uniform
Midriff tops	Lack of sun protection
Clinging lycra type shirts	Not part of the approved school uniform
Makeup/nail polish	Community expectations
